Dear Racer

Please find the attached letter of clearance from the Canadian Customs Offices, which you must have in your possession in order to cross the Canada, US border. This letter will inform the Border Agents why you are coming into the Country and will help to expedite the procedure.

During the past 8 years, while many of you have been crossing the border on your way to Edmonton, Alberta with little concern, there have been some of you that were delayed by searches and paper work. With pre clearance papers in hand, the hope is in lessening your time easing your entrance into Canada, and of course returning home, with the same ease and timely manner. Consideration and respect for the job our respective Border Agents have, is as very valuable asset.

The enclosed letter from Roxann Sparks-Hamilton of the Prairie Region Customs Office will basically clear you across the Canadian Border. Remember to document everything you are bringing across the border and keep that list for your return trip. Please do not try and "hide" items in your trailer as this may cause you to get turned away from the border if you get searched. Pamphlets, Hero Cards and handouts need to be documented as promotional materials.

The Customs Office has asked that everyone entering Canada for the event have proof with them that they are coming for the event. Please make sure you have the copy of the IHRA letter stating that you are traveling to Canada to race at the IHRA Rocky Mountain Nationals. Please be sure that Crew traveling without the Driver have a copy of this letter as well.

All items that are being brought in for re-sale must be stated at the border and duty must be paid on them. Any items that are not sold and are being brought back into the United States will get the duty paid back on them when the appropriate forms are filled out.

Please remember that firearms and drugs are against the law, and will mean automatic refusal, as well as criminal charges being laid.

Also, anyone with any type of convictions against them may not be granted entrance into Canada. Please ensure all individuals traveling with you have had a proper background check done, in order to avoid embarrassing situations, and refusal to pass.

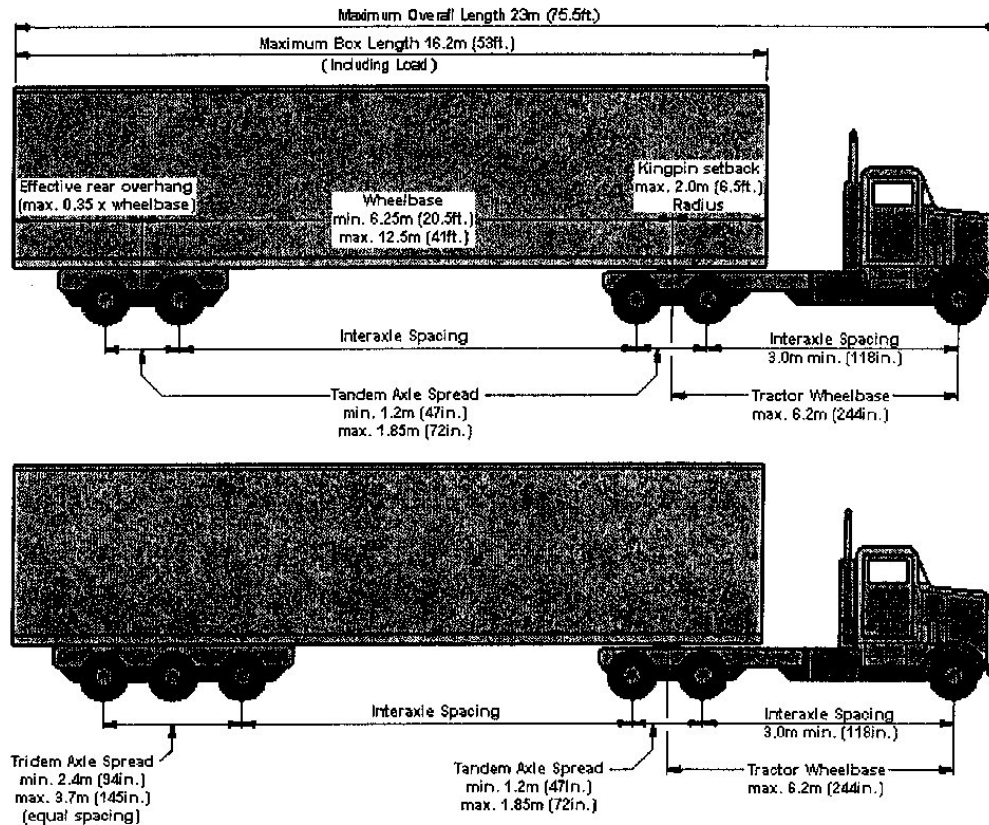
If you are flying or driving to Canada, you MUST have a PASSPORT.

Annual Equipment Exemption for Public Entertainment Vehicle Permit



The following are the measurements for the maximum limits on Tractor Semi-Trailers based on the Province you are traveling through:

	Alberta	Saskatchewan	Manitoba	Ontario
Tractor Wheelbase	244"	244"	244"	244"
Overall Length	75.5 ft	75.6 ft	75.6 ft	75.6 ft

If you exceed these limits you must have a permit prior to entering each of the Provinces. To ensure that you get all necessary permits, make sure you call **PRIOR** to your arrival in the Province with your equipment details.
